

SOME ADDITIONAL INFORMATION RE: COURT

What is a First Appearance?

You as a victim are NOT required to attend an accused's first appearance. If you are in contact with VWAP then they will contact you and let you know when and if you're required to attend Court.

If they do not contact you a Subpoena (Legal Document that obligates you to attend court) will be served upon you from a local police officer. That document will have your trial court date on it.

Free interpretation services

If you are unable to communicate in English, you can call the court to have an interpreter attend to assist you, free of charge. Please call the court where you will be attending and leave a message with:

- your full name and contact information
- the language you speak
- the date and time you are coming to court
- the courtroom number

If you are Ojibway / Cree / Oji-Cree speaking, you have the right to have your trial heard in those languages (or possibly as a bilingual proceeding). To exercise that right you must request that your trial be held in your official language of choice. If you wish to proceed in Ojibway / Cree / Oji-Cree, you should advise the judicial officer or VWAP when they contact you.

What to bring to court

- any papers the police or anyone else gave you relating to your case.
- any papers you think might be important to your case (e.g. letters from doctors, counsellors, employers, schools, volunteer work)
- any person(s) that you wish to assist in providing comfort and support during your trial.
